Independence Day: Interesting Facts, History & Traditions

Fascinating Historical Facts

- The Declaration was adopted on July 4, 1776, but many historians believe that most delegates actually signed the document weeks later, with the formal signing taking place on August 2, 1776.
- Thomas Jefferson was the primary author of the Declaration, although he worked alongside a committee that included John Adams, Benjamin Franklin, Roger Sherman, and Robert R. Livingston.
- The famous opening words, “We hold these truths to be self-evident...”, have become some of the most recognizable phrases in American history.
- Calvin Coolidge, the 30th President of the United States, was born on July 4, 1872, making him the only U.S. president born on Independence Day.

Beloved Traditions

Americans celebrate Independence Day in many festive ways, including:

- Watching spectacular fireworks displays
- Hosting barbecues and cookouts
- Participating in parades and community festivals
- Enjoying concerts and patriotic music
- Flying the American flag
- Spending time with family and friends at parks, lakes, and beaches

Popular foods on the Fourth of July often include hamburgers, hot dogs, corn on the cob, watermelon, apple pie, and homemade ice cream.



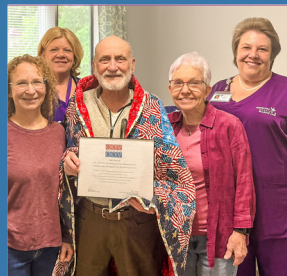
Fun and Lesser-Known Trivia

- The Liberty Bell in Philadelphia is traditionally tapped—not rung—13 times every Independence Day to honor the original 13 colonies.
- Although the Fourth of July is a federal holiday today, it did not become an official unpaid federal holiday until 1870 and was later made a paid federal holiday in 1938.
- The oldest annual Independence Day celebration is held in Bristol, Rhode Island, where festivities date back to 1785.
- The colors of the American flag carry symbolic meaning:
 - Red represents courage and valor.
 - White symbolizes purity and innocence.
 - Blue stands for vigilance, perseverance, and justice.

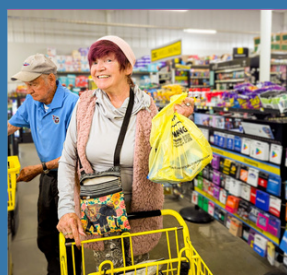
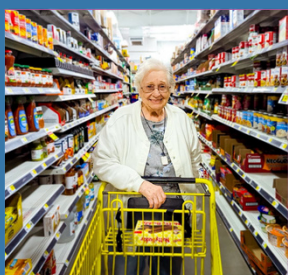

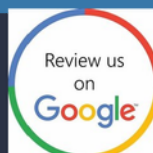
