Father always said “the church doesn’t care about me, they only want another name, another pledge”, I guess I heard that a thousand times.

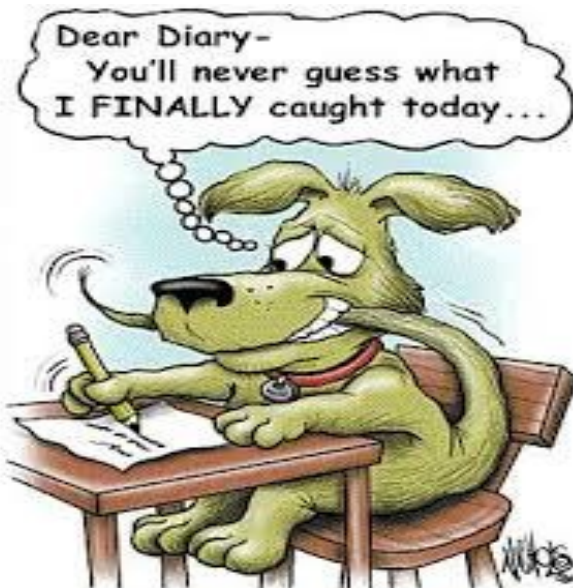

And he wrote, “I was wrong!”

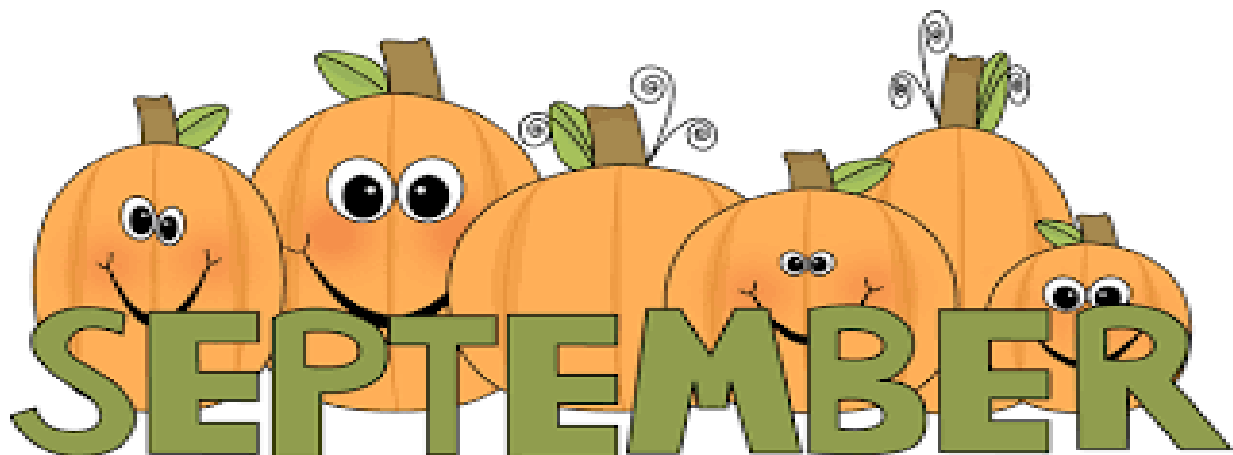
